The Valle d'Aosta is one of the most intriguing wine growing regions in Italy. This small area of Northern Italy is surrounded by the Alps, and is home to the highest elevated vineyards in Europe. You may think that this area is very cold, however they still have quite a Continental climate, including hot summers and cold winters. The grapes grown here can be both esoteric like Neyret or Vien de Nus and common, like Gamay and Pinot Noir. The wines from this region have a very particular style of terroir and style.
